Kindergarten Registration Information

Kindergarten Registration—September 2020

Kindergarten to Grade 8 pre-registration will be open through the TVDSB board website January 20, 2020, for 2020-2021 school year.

Once the pre-registration form has been submitted, parents are encouraged to print a copy and bring the form to the school. Parents who complete the online pre-registration form are required to bring the appropriate documentation to the school to finalize the registration process, proof of birth and proof of address.

Paper copies of Student Registration Forms will continue to be available at the schools for parents who are unable to complete the online student pre-registration form.

Before & After School Child Care

Are you interested in accessing Before & After School Child Care for your child(ren)?

In collaboration with TVDSB approved Child Care Operators, Before & After School Programs are offered at most Thames Valley elementary schools for children registered in the Kindergarten Program and students 6-12 years of age.

In order to indicate your interest in Before & After School care for your child(ren), please **use the links below for your geographic area to add your name to the Child Care Registry**. You will be asked to create an account and respond to various prompts. Once you have added your name to the registry, the child care operator will contact you.

For hours of operation and current fees please refer to the TVDSB website under *Parents, Early Years Programs, Schools with Before & After School Programs* for a complete list.

*Please note that **registration is taken by date** so it is important that you **register sooner than later**. Each 30 days you will be emailed and prompted to indicate if you still require Before & After School care.

The Thames Valley District School Board (TVDSB) Parent Portal is used to provide parents/guardians with information** (see below) about their child's education as well as seek updates and authorizations annually. This method of collecting information streamlines the collection of information and assist schools in reducing the use of paper.

In order to access the TVDSB Parent Portal, parents/guardians must provide their own unique email address to the school when registering the student.

Student Registrations - Current School Year

Parents/Guardians registering students during the current school year will be able to create an account for the TVDSB Parent Portal on the **first day** the student attends school.

Student Registrations - Next School Year (example Kindergarten Registration)

Parents/Guardians registering students for the next school year will receive an email in **August** from the TVDSB inviting parents to create an account for the TVDSB Parent Portal.

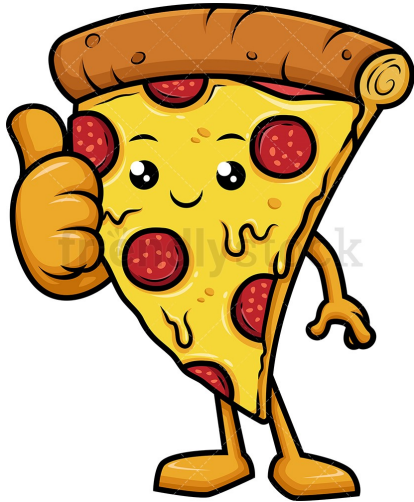
